Dear Cursillista,

Remember the general palanca that was posted all over during your Cursillo weekend? It came from not only all over the US but from other countries. The Archdiocese of Mobile Cursillo Movement has received this general palanca for years but we have not done a very good job of reciprocating. We had a general palanca person for a while and she did a very good job but has since moved out of the area. The Secretariat asked and Rochelle Terrell has agreed to be our general palanca person.

As you may recall the general palanca letters were very colorful and interesting but more importantly, listed the ways in which other Cursillistas were doing palanca for us. But what is palanca? What is a palanca letter? A palanca letter is one that is sent to the candidates and team informing them of the prayers and sacrifices that you are offering to God on their behalf. A letter may be sent explaining what type of palanca is being offered, but the letter is NOT the palanca. The actual palanca is the action – intercessory prayer, sacrifice, or works of mercy, and it can be done without writing a letter.

Rochelle needs each Cursillista to let her know what you are doing regarding palanca for the success of the Cursillo Movement and all the Cursillo weekends. If you attend daily or weekly Mass and, if you pray a rosary daily or on a regular basis, attend adoration regularly, etc with Cursillo as one of your intentions, then please send to Rochelle and she will total and incorporate in the General palanca letter to be sent to other Cursillo weekends. It is Monday morning, the day after Mother's Day and Pentecost. In my morning devotion I have turned back to the reflection in my "Magnificat" for Pentecost Sunday. It was written by Fr. Raniero Cantalamessa, O.F.M.Cap. He is the preacher to the papal household. I just have to share with you two paragraphs from this writing:

"Every time someone has a genuine, strong experience of the Spirit, the most vivid memory of the moment that the person retains is of an intense perception of the Father's love. Witnessing to this, someone said: "All my life long, I had felt unloved. The next day, that feeling vanished entirely. I felt myself immersed in a new experience of the love of God, and from that day it has never left me."

This is the most beautiful moment of any creature's life: to know that one is loved, personally, by God, to feel oneself lifted to the bosom of the Trinity and to find oneself in the flood of love that flows between Father and Son, enfolded in their love, sharing their passionate love for the world. And all of this in one instant, without any need to think about it or for words to say it."

To me that so beautifully sums up the experience of Cursillo. I have heard over and again the witness of the love of God that burst forth in the hearts of those who are living the Cursillo weekend. Very simply it is so overwhelming; words cannot express the touch of God in one's life. Let us continue to persevere in our goal of building up the Cursillo movement in our Archdiocese. Keep the movement in your prayers. Please pray for the leadership that we will continue to be filled with strength, wisdom, understanding, and endurance. You are in our prayers!
