¹³ Jesus replied: Whoever drinks this water will be thirsty again;


but no one who drinks the water that I shall give will ever be thirsty again: the water that I shall give will become a spring of water within, welling up for eternal life.

¹⁵ 'Sir,' said the woman, 'give me some of that water, so that I may never be thirsty or come here again to draw water.'

¹⁶ 'Go and call your husband,' said Jesus to her, 'and come back here.'

- ¹⁷ The woman answered, 'I have no husband.' Jesus said to her, 'You are right to say, "I have no husband";
- ¹⁸ for although you have had five, the one you now have is not your husband. You spoke the truth there.'
- ¹⁹ 'I see you are a prophet, sir,' said the woman.²⁰ 'Our fathers worshipped on this mountain, though
- you say that Jerusalem is the place where one ought to worship.'
- ²¹ Jesus said: Believe me, woman, the hour is coming when you will worship the Father neither on this mountain nor in Jerusalem.
- ²² You worship what you do not know; we worship what we do know; for salvation comes from the Jews.
- ²³ But the hour is coming -- indeed is already here -- when true worshippers will worship the Father in spirit and truth: that is the kind of worshipper the Father seeks.
- ²⁴ God is spirit, and those who worship must worship in spirit and truth.
- ²⁵ The woman said to him, 'I know that Messiah -- that is, Christ -- is coming; and when he comes he will explain everything.'
- ²⁶ Jesus said, 'That is who I am, I who speak to you.'
- At this point his disciples returned and were surprised to find him speaking to a woman, though none of them asked, 'What do you want from her?' or, 'What are you talking to her about?'
- ²⁸ The woman put down her water jar and hurried back to the town to tell the people,
- ²⁹ 'Come and see a man who has told me everything I have done; could this be the Christ?'
- ³⁰ This brought people out of the town and they made their way towards him.
- ³¹ Meanwhile, the disciples were urging him, 'Rabbi, do have something to eat';
- ³² but he said, 'I have food to eat that you do not know about.'
- ³³ So the disciples said to one another, 'Has someone brought him food?'
- ³⁴ But Jesus said: My food is to do the will of the one who sent me, and to complete his work.
- ³⁵ Do you not have a saying: Four months and then the harvest? Well, I tell you, look around you, look

- at the fields; already they are white, ready for harvest!
- ³⁶ Already the reaper is being paid his wages, already he is bringing in the grain for eternal life, so that sower and reaper can rejoice together.
- ³⁷ For here the proverb holds true: one sows, another reaps;
- ³⁸ I sent you to reap a harvest you have not laboured for. Others have laboured for it; and you have come into the rewards of their labour.
- ³⁹ Many Samaritans of that town believed in him on the strength of the woman's words of testimony, 'He told me everything I have done.'
- ⁴⁰ So, when the Samaritans came up to him, they begged him to stay with them. He stayed for two days, and
- ⁴¹ many more came to believe on the strength of the words he spoke to them;
- ⁴² and they said to the woman, 'Now we believe no longer because of what you told us; we have heard him ourselves and we know that he is indeed the Saviour of the world.'

SEARCH NEWS:

Search retreat program in the Archdiocese of Mobile is for teens, by teens. It is really a Junior Cursillo program for our high school youth. Once you attend the Search retreat, you can participate the following year by applying to be on the Search and Palanca team. These past two years, we have experienced solid growth and a deeper understanding of the dynamics of bringing our youth to Christ during the course of a retreat weekend. Teens are changed when they encounter the true beauty and depth of their Catholic faith, especially when it comes through the witness of their peers. That is what a Search Retreat is all about- helping teens realize that what they are really searching for is Jesus Christ. Through the retreats structure to the location of the retreatm everything is designed to lead the teens to Christ and the Sacraments.

All of the talks (teens' testimonies), small group discussions, prayers, activities, and palancas are led by the Search team. The team members really develop over the course of the year into strong, faithful, and committed Catholics who are leaders in their parishes. Hey are a blessing to the Archdiocese and to the teens they serve on our annual retreats. Each year, we offer two retreats for high schoool youth- one in the Montgomery, area and one the Mobile area. They are open to all high school youth-Catholic and non-Catholic.

I would invite the Cursillo family to pray for the Search retreat program, offer palancas for our retreat weekends, and consider sponsoring a Search team member or Searcher (retreat participant) for the weekend retreats. The cost for one retreat is \$85.00. We do not charge the Search retreat team any fees to be on the team since they already pour out their time and energy as committed team members.
