WOMEN'S HEALTH SERVICES, INC.

Hello dear Cursillistas Brothers and Sisters! In recent years God has worked on my heart in tremendous ways. After living our Cursillo weekends, my husband and I loved acknowledging Jesus in the details of our lives in a new way! As most of you know, my husband, Bernie Brannan, passed away two years ago June 1. One year later, God put it on my heart, and clearly guided me to start a ministry for Him. The result is Women's Health Services, a mobile ultrasound clinic custom built to medical specifications that can be driven directly to the doors of abortion clinics. There it serves as the final lifeline to babies before the mothers enter to have an abortion.

To have an abortion in Alabama, mothers are required to make two visits to an abortion clinic, waiting 72 hours between visits. Since many abortion decisions are made in haste due to fear and pressure, many Alabama mothers flee to abortion clinics that are less regulated in Georgia. For example, mothers can drive to Columbus, Georgia, for one visit to the abortion clinic, and be in and out in 2 to 4 hours. That's why we'll see many mothers from Alabama at abortion sites to which we drive the our mobile unit.

In the last year God has led His believers to take action through prayer and financial giving to fund the mobile clinic vehicle (\$180K), ultrasound machine (\$42K) and first quarter operations (\$57K). This enabled us to purchase the first inventory of medical operational supplies, as well as liability and medical malpractice insurance to cover the vehicle and directors and officers. Hopefully ALL cracks are closed that Satan might exploit to stop us from providing hope and refuge to desperate mothers and fathers seeking to abort their God-given babies.

The spiritual warfare against such a ministry is real. Our medical director describes it as, "we are going to the gates of Hell, redirecting traffic." We are under intense attack by Satan, who wants nothing more than for mothers to prevent a child from living out the plan God created before that child was ever formed in the mother's womb. Satan also wants the parents of aborted children to live in separation from God, often suffering from shame and guilt in silence. Such is what we are here to overcome, one mother at a time.

We desperately need your daily prayer to withstand the attacks of Satan against us. I hope each of you will pray for at least one person to share our passion to serve the Lord by protecting the image of God that is under attack through abortion. Are you grouping? Hopefully you can share this with your reunion group and ultreya. Thank you in advance for your commitment.
