Editor's note: The following is a memo from the National Secretariat that encourages local secretariats to plan a Cursillo de Cursillo weekend workshop. It includes a list of topics from which to choose. Our Secretariat may consider such a workshop but no announcement has been made as yet. The memo also outlines topics for the School of Leaders for consideration as well.

Subject: Content for School of Leaders and Regional Encounters

How do we continue to live the joyful proclamation of the Good News of God's love in the US Cursillo Movement? The goal is to encourage every diocese in the 12 Regions to schedule a Cursillo de Cursillos (CDC). Currently, there are four scheduled for 2023; Diocese of Evansville, Diocese of Oakland, Diocese of Covington, Lexington, and Cincinnati together, and the Diocese of Sacramento. The biggest challenge for a diocese in agreeing to have a CDC, is the lack of funds; therefore, you can always suggest that 2 or 3 neighboring dioceses have a CDC together so they can share the expense. This works really well.

A second option you can offer a diocese that absolutely cannot afford a CDC is to offer a one-day or two-day workshop. Below is a list of topics for the Secretariat to review. Ask the Secretariat if there are any special topics or needs, they would like covered during the workshop that are not listed below. You can customize a workshop according to the current Diocesan Cursillo needs.

JESUS TOLD A PARABLE TO THE PHARISEES. EXPERTS AND WISDOM

Experts! Who are the Experts? We tend to think the Experts are those who possess a very high level of knowledge about a particular subject. We consider them to have a certain amount of wisdom because of their knowledge. We listen and heed their expertise in hopes of possessing their wisdom.

St. Paul posed a very good question for us in his letter to the Corinthians. "Has not God made the wisdom of the world foolish?"

And we can ask ourselves, are the experts today wise or foolish? Are they only concerned about the wisdom of the world?

A lot of contemporary wisdom

seems to revolve around being in control and being the master of our own destiny. Seeking only what is best for ourselves.

Yes, we need wisdom to navigate through and in our world. We need a certain amount of wisdom to determine if our wisdom is good wisdom or foolish wisdom. St. Paul puts it rather straight forward.


